## eckersleyoxford

### where is the school

Eckersley Oxford is right in the city centre near the Oxford University colleges, shops, theatres and museums.

We are just 1 minute's walk from the Gloucester Green bus station where buses from the airports arrive.

We are 10 minutes' walk from the railway station.

Buses from all parts of Oxford stop near the school.

### how to get oxford

#### If you travel to Britain by air:

Bus from Heathrow Airport to Oxford: The Airline (bus)

If you arrive at terminal 1, 2 or 3 go to the central bus station bay 14A

Journey time: 90 minutes

If you arrive at terminal 5 go to bay 11

Journey time: 80 minutes

Every 30 minutes

Fare: One-way £20 Return (3 months) £25

Bus from Gatwick Airport to Oxford: The Airline (bus)

If you arrive at the North terminal got to bay 4 and from the South terminal bus departs from upper forecourt

Every hour: Journey time: 2 - 2 1/2 hours

Fare: One-way £25 Return (3 months) £35

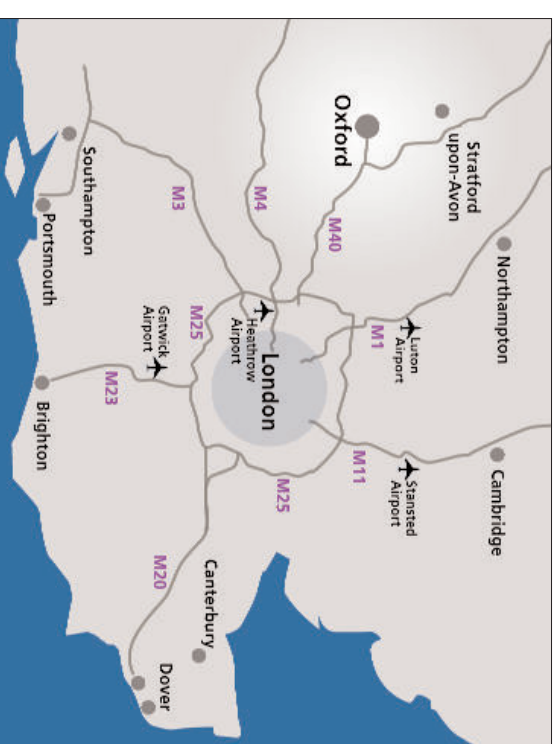
Bus from Luton or Stansted Airport to Oxford: National Express (bus)

## how to travel to oxford

### **If you travel to Britain by train (Eurostar) through the Channel Tunnel:**

You will arrive at London (Waterloo), and can travel to Oxford by train or by bus

### **Train from London Paddington station to Oxford**

Every 20 - 30 minutes. Journey time about 1 hour

### **Bus from London to Oxford (Gloucester Green bus station):**

#### **Oxford Tube or Oxford Express**

From Buckingham Palace Road, bus stop number 10

Single fare (one-way): £14, Return fare (valid up to 3 months): £20

## arrival in oxford

When you arrive at Oxford Railway Station, or at Gloucester Green bus station, you should take a taxi to the address where you will be staying. At the bus station, the taxi rank is on the other side of Gloucester Green, the small square.
